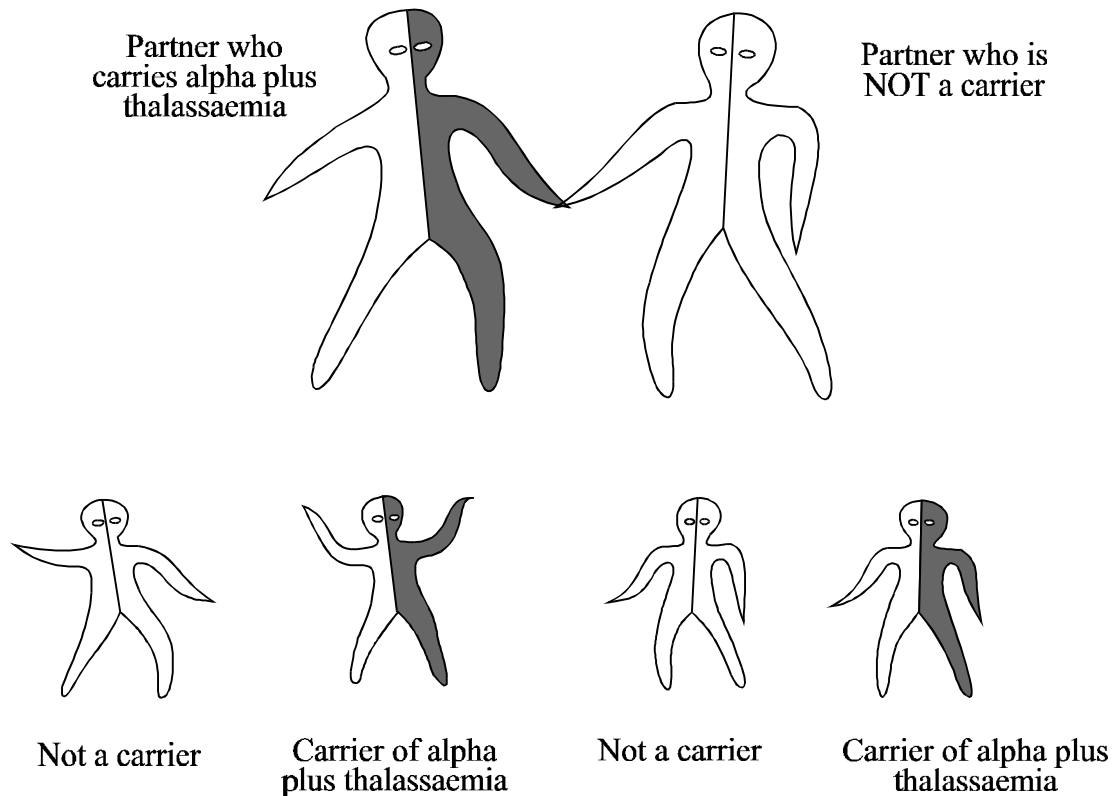


Implications for a Child when One Partner carries Alpha plus Thalassaemia and the Other does not carry any Haemoglobin Disorder

There is no particular problem for this couple. This combination cannot cause an inherited anaemia in their children.



In each pregnancy there are two possibilities:

- The child may not carry any haemoglobin disorder.
- The child may carry alpha plus thalassaemia. This is harmless.

This couple has the same chance of a healthy family as other couples.
